The partnership with Peter Lyngdorf and Steinway began back in 2007, when the high quality piano maker gave Peter Lyngdorf the exclusive rights to manufacture the highest quality sound systems possible. The first system created under the Steinway Lyngdorf name was called the Model D which shares its name with the concert grand piano in the Steinway family of musical instruments. (The Model D made its debut in 2007 and sold for \$ 155,000.00 US dollars which has been increased over the years to a current price of \$188,000.00 US dollars.)

Currently there are three different speaker systems manufactured by Steinway Lyngdorf, also named after the different pianos in the Steinway musical instrument family, the Model C, M and the S-Systems. Since its release in 2011, the Model S system is the first system manufactured by Steinway Lyngdorf that can be obtained without being a member of the million dollar club or a new TN Lottery winner. The Model S System entry level pricing is at \$22,000.00 US dollars making the S System a true bargain for someone who really appreciates great music reproduction. It's no wonder the praises and accolades keep coming in.
